**Internal Emergency** - Any emergency situation that occurs within MISH or on grounds in which groups of patients, visitors, and staff has been placed under a threat of physical harm due to change in environmental conditions.

**External Emergency** - Any situation occurring off of MSH property which requires assistance from MISH staff or use of MISH facilities to aid victims of a disaster or aid another hospital that may have been damaged or taken out of service due to an emergency.

## **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. Person/persons becoming aware of a catastrophic disaster notify administration/CEO immediately
- 2. CEO or designee have the authority to activate Code Orange
- 3. Code Orange is announced slowly and clearly 3 times
- CODE ORANGE Catastrophic Disaster ALL available staff Gather in LOCATION (Default LOBBY) Code Orange – Catastrophic Disaster – ALL available staff Gather in Lobby Code Orange – Catastrophic Disaster – ALL available staff Gather in Lobby Code Orange – Catastrophic Disaster – ALL available staff Gather in Lobby
- 4. A hard copy of the Emergency Management Plan (EMP) is kept in the Incident Command Center
- 5. CEO activates the EMP and the "initial response leadership tree"
- 6. CEO and Leadership work together to assess and evaluate the extent and type of emergency, and initiate an initial response plan
- 7. Individuals in the leadership tree are then responsible for directing the individuals under them as outlined in the Emergency Response Organization Chart
- 8. General roles and responsibility by job description are distributed to as described below to prompt procedure.
