PROCEDURE:

- 1. If small fire in a localized area, attempt to extinguish the fire.
- 2. Rescue any persons in immediate danger and Activate nearest fire alarm.
- 3. Turn off the oxygen and/or nitrous supply at the main valves WHENEVER POSSIBLE
 - a. Turn-off valves are located just outside each individual operating room.
 - b. provide patient with an 02 tank before turning off the main valves if/when needed
- 4. Evacuate from building by using the designated exits for your department/area.
- 5. Handicapped or non-ambulatory patients should be evacuated behind ambulatory patients/staff
- 6. DESIGNATED MEETING AREA Front of Building

Note: If attempts to extinguish the fire are unsuccessful, evacuate the area immediately.

Procedure in the event of a fire:

- R RESCUE persons in immediate danger
- A ALARM sound the alarm
- **C** CONFINE fire
- **E** EXTINGUISH fire or EVACUATE area

- **Operation of a fire extinguisher is as follows:**
 - **P** PULL the pin
 - **A** AIM the nozzle
 - ${\bf S}-{\bf S}$ queeze the handle
 - **S** SWEEP from side to side
- Call 911 if fire cannot be extinguished
- Close ALL Doors
- Shut off medical gases valves Valves located: Mechanical room (req. key, main), RN station, Pre-Op, North Hallway by ICU doors, and ICU RN station
